



In 2022, 4% of Emergency Department (ED) visits were for behavioral health.






Of those who came to the ED, 21% of adults and 10% of kids received inpatient care for their behavioral health condition.



Hospital EDs see a disproportionate number of patients who are uninsured, receive Medicaid and are Black.



It takes behavioral health patients longer to be discharged from the ED than other patients. For adults the median time to discharge is 1.5 times longer, and for kids it's 1.75 times longer.
