Joshua Torbich is the Chief Executive Officer of Christian Recovery Centers, Inc., a leading faith-based organization serving individuals impacted by addiction. In Brunswick County NC he has the privilege to serve on the Brunswick County Mental Health and Addiction Commission, where he leads collaborative efforts to address these issues at the community level. Josh is also the President of the NC based group, Bridge to 100, this network represents over 4k residential beds held by over 30 NC based SUD treatment and recovery programs. Nationally, he holds the position of President for the Bluegrass District of Citygate Network, a prominent association of life transformation ministries. Josh holds a Master's degree in Education, with a concentration in Business Management and Christian Leadership.

Driven by vision and compassion, Josh has played a pivotal role in transforming Christian Recovery Centers, Inc. into a vital resource across the Carolinas. Under his leadership, the organization has grown from serving just 12 individuals at a single location to providing over 200 no-cost residential treatment, recovery, and re-entry program beds. His innovative approach to substance use disorder (SUD) treatment—integrating the strengths of faith and science—has helped thousands move from suffering to holistic well-being.

Josh's journey is deeply personal. In 2013, he found his life unraveling due to a severe addiction to alcohol and heroin. With few resources and limited options, he turned to the only help available: free recovery services. That experience became the foundation for his life's mission. As a recovered opioid user and alcoholic, Josh brings firsthand insight and empathy to his work. He is widely regarded as an expert in the field and is frequently invited to speak at educational institutions and community forums to raise awareness and promote healing. As an ordained

minister, he often fills pulpits across the country, sharing a message of God's goodness, hope, and restoration. Josh has dedicated his life to reaching those devastated by addiction and guiding them toward freedom. His driving passion is to create pathways of hope—offering others the same opportunity for transformation that once saved his own life.
